



Terms & Conditions: Yorkshire Marathon 2024

(Charity Place)

Entry Fees & Sponsorship Target

Entry donation	£40 (to be paid via Beacon upon sign up)
Total sponsorship target	£250 (excluding GiftAid)
Sponsorship due dates	100% of target must be raised by 29/08/2024

All funds raised from your participation in the Yorkshire Marathon 2024 should be paid to York Mind in £ sterling. Though a fundraising target has been set, the aim is for you to raise as much as possible.

Entry Process

1. Participant signs up online.
2. The fundraising team will confirm the space for the participant.
3. A PIN code issued to potential participant by York Mind via email (PIN code must be activated by the participant within 2 weeks).
4. Once the PIN code is activated, a Fundraising Pack and monthly emails are sent out to the participant until the date of the race.

Withdrawal policy

If there is a change in circumstances resulting in you having to withdraw your place in the Yorkshire Marathon, please contact our fundraising team and they will speak with you about the next steps.

The dates set out below are based upon deadlines for withdrawing from previous Yorkshire Marathon events by the event organisers. Within the time leading up to the event, these could be subject to change dependent on available spaces. On the date you received these terms & conditions, these were the deadlines we were aware of.

- If you withdraw your entry **before 31st August 2024** we will be able to reallocate your place to another runner and you will not be required to raise our minimum sponsorship.
- If you withdraw your entry **after 31st August 2024**, we will be unable to reallocate your place to another runner, and you will be required to raise donations another way or make a donation of £50.00, to be received by York Mind no later than 4 weeks after the event date.
- If you withdraw from the race and have already raised funds you must offer to return them to your sponsors. If they do not wish for a refund, the funds must be paid to York Mind.

All participants:

- You confirm that you are medically fit and that you participate in the event at your own risk. York Mind will not be held responsible for injury or illness resulting from your participation.
- You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions issued by the race organisers and to comply with these.
- The minimum age for this event is 18. You confirm you will be the minimum age on race day.
- You acknowledge that York Mind incur costs as a result of you joining Team York Mind (e.g. cost of your entry place, producing and sending fundraising pack) for this challenge. The objective is for you to raise as much sponsorship as possible.
- Should you, for whatever reason, not take part in the race, all sponsorship raised must be offered in return to your sponsors. If they do not wish for a refund, the funds must be paid to York Mind.

- You have provided York Mind information about you and consent to York Mind using this data. You understand that it will be necessary for York Mind to share the data with the race organisers in order to participate in this event.
- York Mind do not sell or swap your details with any third parties, but in order to carry out our work we may need to pass your details to service companies authorised to act on our behalf.
- York Mind will keep your details on our database so we can provide you with the best possible support every time you contact us.
- All participants, supporters and spectators confirm that they are happy for their names, video footage and photographs taken of them during the event to be used by York Mind for commercial and fundraising purposes including, but not limited to marketing material, television broadcasts, social media, advertising, publications, and other documents or mediums that may be made available to the public. Photographs of children will not be used in this manner without express written consent; unless the images are incidental, for example, children's images at the starting line.
